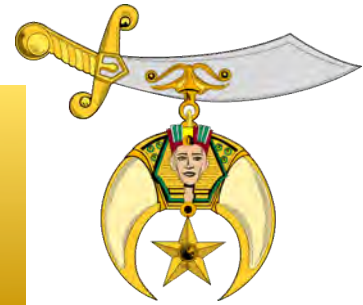

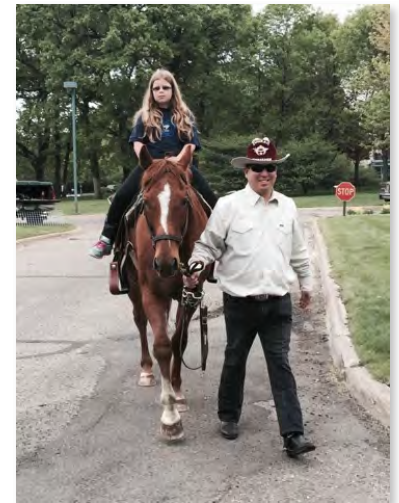

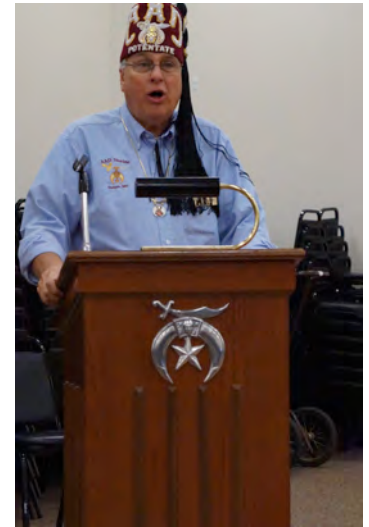
2015 Rainbow of Hope Winners

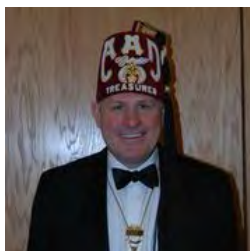

AAD Dune Buggy Patrol

Greeting Nobles

The Dune Buggy Patrol Unit has been busy over the winter doing a "Frame Up" overhaul on Buggy #7. This Buggy was originally purchased by Harry Pearson back in the day when Dune Buggy Members owned and maintained their own Dune Buggies. Subsequently, ownership of the Buggies was transferred to Aad Temple. Overhaul work includes removal of the body to provide access to work on the chassis, replacement of floor pans, new link & king pins, installing dual chamber master brake cylinder, new brake lines, replacing rear drum brakes with disc brakes, new clutch cable, rebuilding steering box, installing a new wiring kit, switching existing motor with rebuilt motor, repair of fiberglass body, new fuel tank, and complete painting of all metal components. Attached are a few photos showing different phases of the process. This unit should be parade-ready very soon. Many thanks to our lead technician/foreman, Noble Mike Daigle, for spearheading this rebuild. Also thanks to Nobles Jamo Anderson, Scott Twining (for use of his shop!), Dave Nelson, Chuck Swanson, and Aaron Peterson for their efforts. We'll have a good, safe, and reliable unit when the work is complete. We hope to do another Buggy in May, if time allows. The annual Dune Buggy Patrol Vidalia Onion Sale was held in early May; keep an eye out for results in the next newsletter.
